



WAITING LIST OPENING  
TENANT-BASED HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER (SECTION 8) PROGRAM

The Housing Authority of the Town of West Hartford (WHHA) will be accepting Preliminary Applications for the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program.

The HCV Program is a federally funded program which subsidizes decent, safe, and sanitary housing for low-income persons. Applicants must meet all U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and WHHA income and eligibility guidelines. The current income limits are listed below:

Interested applicants must submit a pre-application online at <https://portals.westhartfordha.org/> between October 2, 2023, 8:30am and October 12, 2023, 11:59pm.

**Only one pre-application per family will be accepted; duplicate pre-applications will be disqualified.**

This pre-application is accessible through any computer, tablet, or smart phone. After successfully completing the pre-application, you will receive a confirmation email of your application submission. You may also print this confirmation.

The West Hartford Housing Authority will use a Random-Draw Lottery System to select **1000 pre-applications**. Those chosen in the lottery will be notified by email and/or mail no later than **October 31, 2023**. All incomplete, disqualified or remaining pre-applications will be discarded with no further notice. **If you do not receive an acceptance email or letter by October 31, 2023, your pre-application was not drawn in the lottery.**
